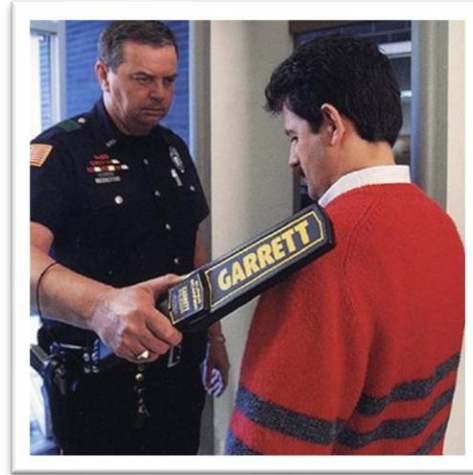
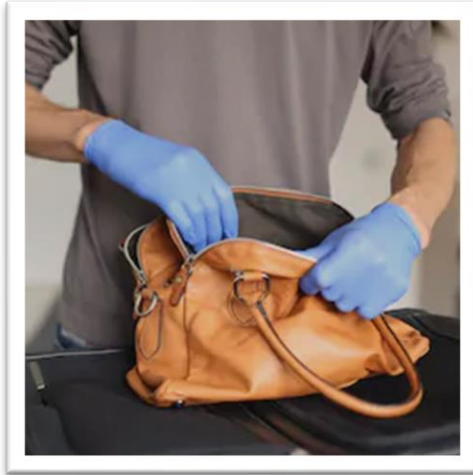




Going to a concert at RAC Arena



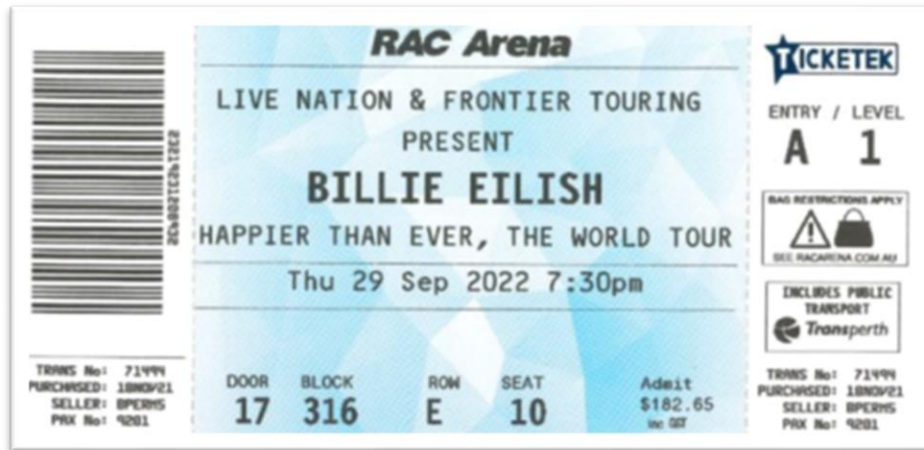
I'm going to RAC Arena. There will be lots of people. I will wait my turn and stay in the line to show the staff my ticket.

The Arena will be very crowded. When the performance starts it will be dark where we sit, so that we can see the stage all lit up.



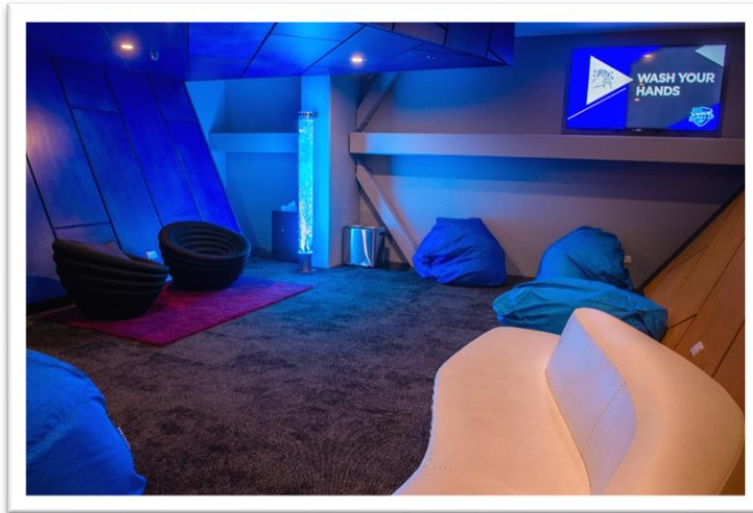
There might be loud music and flashing lights
